Equipment needed:

Graduated cylinder, amber bottle, stirring rod

Auxiliary Labels/Storage: Refrigerate; Shake Well

Room Temperature Storage=14 days

Directions:

- 1. Empty contents of capsules into a graduate.
- 2. Add sodium bicarbonate 8.4% solution to graduate.
- 3. Allow mixture to sit for 30 minutes.
- 4. Stir well to mix.

Final Product Description: Thin, white suspension (milky in appearance)

This description is for exact products and manufacturers specified below and may vary with substitutions.

Note: Prepare sodium bicarbonate 8.4% solution by placing 1 measuring teaspoonful of baking soda into 240ml of warm water and allowing this to dissolve (*Annals of Pharmacotherapy. 1998; (32): 480*). Sodium bicarbonate 8.4% for injection can be substituted for prepared solution.
